

Create Your Own Play Money!

Does your child love drawing and using their imagination? Let them design their own money! This activity helps them learn about money while having fun with art.

Money usually has famous people or important figures on it. Today, your child gets to decide who will be on their own special bill! Follow the steps below to make your own play money.

What Your Child Will Learn:



Basic concepts about denominations and the importance of figures on money.



Value recognition and understanding the worth of money

Supplies You'll Need:

Colored pencils, markers, or crayons

What To Do:

- 1. Bill Introduction: Give your child a real bill to look at. This will help them understand where to place the denomination and person's image.
- Think of a Person: It could be someone your child admires, like a family member, a friend, a superhero, or even themselves!
- 3. Draw and Color: Have your child use the following page to draw their custom bill. Encourage your child to add lot of color and get creative!
- 4. Add Numbers: Guide your child in deciding how much the bill is worth. Is it \$1, \$5, \$10, or even more? Have them incorporate the number on the bill.
- 5. Have fun! Share this activity with family and friends to see what designs they come up with!
